DRESS REHEARSAL TIMES!!!!

ALL MUSIC STUDENTS MUST BE ON TIME FOR DRESS REHEARSAL!!! To make the best use of our time and to avoid congestion in certain areas, we will use the following warm up schedule. As we have a small amount of time, plan ahead so that you are **on time!**

Tuesday, May 14

5:00pm Intermediate Voices including Grade 10 Chamber Choir arrive
5:15pm Intermediate Voices rehearse with stage plan in Auditorium
(After rehearsal Intermediate Voices not in Chamber Choir go to Cafeteria. Chamber Choir members go to Rm 128)
5:15pm Grade 9 Voices Arrive
5:30pm Grade 9 Voices rehearse with stage plan in Auditorium
(After rehearsal Grade 9 Voices not in band or String Orchestra go to cafeteria)
5:30pm String Orchestra Arrives
5:45pm String Orchestra rehearses with stage plan in Auditorium
(After rehearsal – String Orchestra members leave instruments and music set up and if you are not in other ensembles – go to Cafeteria)
5:45pm Grade 10 Band members not in other ensembles arrive
6:00pm Grade 10 Band warm up in Band Room
(After warm-up Grade 10 Band students in Intermediate Voices move to Cafeteria.
Grade 10 Band members in Chamber Choir go to Rm 128
Grade 10 students in band only move to Cafeteria with instruments and music – do not play instruments in Cafeteria)
6:00pm Grade 9 Band arrive
6:00pm Grade 11/12 Chamber Choir members arrive who are not in String Orchestra
6:15pm Grade 9 Band warm-up on stage in Auditorium.
(After warm-up Grade 9 Band members move with instruments and music to the Cafeteria. Do not play instruments in Cafeteria
6:15pm Grade 10/11/12 Chamber Choir members warm-up in Room 128
6:15pm Grade 11/12 Wind Ensemble members arrive
6:30pm Wind Ensemble warm-up in band room
(After warm-up Wind Ensemble members move quickly to Cafeteria)
6:35pm All Grade 9 Band line up in cafeteria and walk on to stage left with instruments and music then return to the cafeteria to line up for Ongazi.
6:40pm All Grade 10 Band line up in cafeteria and move to assigned seating. Grade 10 Band members in choir or String Orchestra leave your instrument and music and come back to the cafeteria to line up for Intermediate Voices.
6:45 pm All Intermediate Voices including ALL Grade 10 – 12 Chamber Choir, String Orchestra members in choir and Grade 10 band members in choir line up in Cafeteria and move to assigned seating in concert order in Auditorium.
6:50pm Grade 11/12 Wind Ensemble members line up in Cafeteria and move to assigned seating in concert order in Auditorium.
6:55pm Grade 9 Choir and Band move onto risers, String Orchestra members not in Grade 9 Choir line up in Cafeteria and move to Concert Positions

5:30pm Senior Voices and Chamber Choir arrive in uniform
5:45pm Senior Voices and Chamber Choir rehearse with stage plan in Auditorium
(After rehearsal, Choir members not in Band go to Cafeteria)
6:00pm Wind Ensemble not in Choirs arrive
6:15PM Wind Ensemble warm-up on stage
(Wind Ensemble members not in Choir or Grade 11/12 Band remain in position on stage)
6:15pm Grade 11/12 Band Arrives
6:30pm Grade 11/12 Band warm up in band room
(After rehearsal, All Band Members move to assigned seating in Auditorium in concert order. Students in Grade 11/12 Band only remain in assigned seating positions.
Students in Wind Ensemble who are not in Chamber Choir remain in concert positions.
6:45pm Senior Voices not in Chamber Choir line up in Cafeteria and move to assigned seating in the Auditorium
6:50pm Chamber Choir lines up in Cafeteria and moves to Risers in Auditorium

CONCERT UNIFORM

Grade 9: Black Dress Pants Black Socks, Black Dress Shoes, Campbell Music T-Shirt
Senior Women: Black Uniform Dress, Green Scarf, black nylons/knee highs low-heeled dress shoes (preferably closed-toe)
Senior Men: Black long-sleeved collared dress shirt, Black dress pants, Black socks, Black dress shoes Grey Vest and Black Campbell Music Tie

NO JEANS, CASUAL PANTS, WATCHES, BRACELETS, OR RUNNING SHOES!
CELL PHONES MUST BE STORED IN Room 128, Room 125 or the Band Room
HAIR MUST BE PULLED BACK FROM FACE WITH HAIR TIES!

CONCERT ETIQUETTE

It is very important that all music students be absolutely silent when changing over the groups in the middle of the concert!

All students are to be in the auditorium to watch each group perform until the end of the concerts. Seats will be reserved for each concert group at the front of the auditorium.

IMPORTANT INFO FOR BAND STUDENTS!

Students with medium and small instruments will hold their instruments and music at their assigned seating spot before and after they have performed. Tuba, Euphonium, Baritone Sax, and Bass Clarinet players will place their instruments at the assigned spots at the side of the auditorium. Bands will have assigned seating in front of the band set-up, Choirs will have assigned seating in front of the choir set-up!

ABSOLUTELY NO STUDENTS ARE TO BE IN THE HALLS BEFORE OR DURING THE PERFORMANCE!!!

CLEAN-UP RESPONSIBILITIES

All choir students are responsible for assisting with the cleanup after the Tuesday night concert.

Intermediate Voices and Grade 11/12 Chamber Choir members move onto risers stage left from assigned seating

Intermediate Voices with 11/12 Chamber Choir Members

Intermediate Voices not in Chamber Choir, Grade 10 Band or Wind Ensemble move to assigned seating

Intermediate Voices in Grade 10 Band go back to stage entering stage left

Chamber Choir members not in Grade 10 Band remain on risers

Grade 10 Band not in Wind Ensemble or Chamber Choir move off stage right with instruments and music and go to assigned seating.

If you are in Grade 10 Band and Chamber Choir, give your instrument and music to a fellow student when you go to the riser off stage right

If you are in Grade 10 Band, Chamber Choir and Wind Ensemble – leave your instrument and music with a Grade 10 Wind Ensemble member who is not in Chamber Choir and move off the stage - stage right.

If you are in Grade 10 Band and Wind Ensemble – but not in Chamber Choir – remain on stage and move to your Wind Ensemble position.
